- (A) Maintenance Mechanics (PACE) do general maintenance on equipment, facilities, etc. on-site. Mechanical Maintenance Technicians (non-union) do maintenance, repair and installation of equipment, systems, etc., identified as "Critical Systems".
- (B) A Welder (PACE) performs welding for general maintenance, installation tasks, etc. A Welder (non-union) performs welding for experimental/scientific projects and critical, high-tolerance welds (e.g., ANSI standards)
