The List of the Applicable Laws and Regulations (List A) for the Idaho National Engineering and Environmental Laboratory (INEEL) has been developed in accordance with DEAR 970.5204-78, *Laws, Regulations, and DOE Directives (June 1997)*.

In accordance with DEAR 970.5204-78, List A is appended to this contract for information, and omission of any applicable law or regulation from List A does not affect the obligation of the contractor to comply with such law or regulation pursuant to the terms of the contract. List A is a compilation, for information, of the major laws and regulations, major permits, and major agreements with regulators applicable to work performed under the terms and conditions of this contract.

Executive Orders are not included in List A. Direction contained in Executive Orders that affect performance of work under Department of Energy Contracts is normally assimilated into appropriate laws and regulations, which include the Federal and Department of Energy Acquisition Regulations. The Department Procurement Executive may, on a case basis, issue direction in the form of Procurement Letters directing specific implementation actions based on Executive Orders.

The contractor shall make recommendations annually for update to List A in conjunction with the annual update to the Safety Management System Description Document as discussed in DEAR 970-5204-2, *Integration of Environment, Safety, and Health into Work Planning and Execution (June 1997)*.
