1. WORKSCOPE**1.1 Task Description**

The INL Occupational Medicine Program will provide "for cause" drug and alcohol testing services to BBWI for the Advanced Mixed Waste Treatment Facility Project. This service would only be requested by BBWI of BEA should an occasion arise in which immediate testing is required, such as when a BBWI employee is acting aberrantly and drug/alcohol use is suspected.

1.2 Assumptions

BEA maintains the capability of testing for drug and alcohol at both its clinics during established operating hours (at the CFA medical clinic and the WCB medical clinic). BBWI arranges for any routine or non emergency testing for drug and alcohol via other service providers.

2. RESPONSIBILITIES**2.1 BBWI's Responsibilities**

- 2.1.1 Notify the appropriate BEA Medical Clinic (CFA or WCB) of the desire to obtain a stat Breathalyzer test and Urine SAMHSA 5 drug panel for an employee that BBWI is transporting to that facility.
- 2.1.2 Provide transport, escorting, and monitoring of the individual to be tested at the medical clinic.
- 2.1.3 When appropriate, provide the employee transportation off site/home, ensuring that the individual is not allowed to drive self.
- 2.1.4 As appropriate, invoke BBWI policies concerning consequences to the employee when impairment from drugs and/or alcohol in the workplace is confirmed.
- 2.1.5 Retain all records associated with the testing in accordance with existing medical record retention requirements.

2.2 BEA's Responsibilities:

- 2.2.1 Ensure the RN who performs the testing is Breath Alcohol Technician (BAT) trained to perform the Breathalyzer test and complete the Chain of Custody form/process for the SAMHSA 5 drug panel.
- 2.2.2 Provide results of the testing to the AMWTP Medical Director.

3. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

The AMWTP Medical Director is responsible to perform all testing result notifications, including those required by regulation.

4. FUNDING

BBWI funds the services that it purchases from BEA through the mechanism of a Memorandum of Purchase Order. The MPO C05-000001 provides for the purchase by BBWI of a variety of BEA services including security related services. The MPO also provides for the purchase of short term low dollar value services via the mechanism of Task Baseline Agreements. See activities BEA-AMWTP 7 and 20 in the referenced MPO. Monthly BEA submits an invoice to BBWI for the payment of the activities performed by BEA at the request of BBWI during the prior month.


