

WROC Tour

The Waste Reduction Operations Complex, or WROC, is the future home of essential components of the National Security, Critical Infrastructure Test Range. This is where the Remote Command and Control Center and the Transportation Test Bed will be located. The facilities here are in great shape and represent isolated infrastructure that are perfect for supporting the INEEL's Critical Infrastructure Test Range activities. The intention is to have this area serve as the hub for National Security/Test Range activities, to the extent practical. The transition of these facilities to the National Security Program is fairly recent but we have already used some of the buildings at this campus for training of first responders and National Guard Civil Support Teams.

During the presentation at the Idaho Research Center in Idaho Falls, you heard about a program to detect nuclear material in cargo containers through the use of Pulsed Photonuclear Assessment Technique. Much of the activity for that program will take place on this campus of the Test Range. The high bay building will be used for full scale, indoor testing and the remoteness of this site will allow us to prototype very large systems and safely operate the systems outdoors.
